

Public Hearing and Comment Notice

To all interested citizens of Mayfield, Kentucky:

The Kentucky Department for Local Government is accepting applications under the 2021 Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) Program. The City of Mayfield intends to apply for assistance to construct a concrete barrier to protect the Industrial Drive Substation from future weather-related damage. Funds in the amount of \$1.2 million will be requested from the Kentucky Department of Local Government, of which is expected to significantly benefit low to moderate income persons. The project is not expected to cause significant displacement or disruption of Mayfield citizens.

The City of Mayfield will hold a public hearing prior to the submission of the grant application. The public hearing will be held virtually on March 13 at 8 a.m. Central Standard Time.
